Healing Touch for Health and Wellness

March 14th – 7:00pm

Richard Sahr will present a free program on Healing Touch. **Seating is limited to 25 people so call for a reservation.** Healing Touch is an alternative therapy that complements traditional medicine, can stand alone and can work for any age. Sometimes Healing Touch can help when traditional medicine doesn't seem to work...and there are NO SIDE EFFECTS! That is why more U.S. hospitals, including Albany Medical Center, are providing Healing Touch sessions when requested. The goal of Healing Touch is to support the body's wisdom to heal itself. Some of the topics that will be covered are:

- How does it work?
- What illnesses can it help?
- Who is the healer?
- How can one find a practitioner?
- What characteristics should a practitioner have?
- What are you likely to experience during a session?
- How long does a session last and how much will it cost?
